



1. Introduction

To make this site work properly, we sometimes place small data files called cookies on your device. Like many other websites, we may use them to help you personalise your online experience.

2. What is a Cookie?

A cookie is a small text file that a website saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. It enables the website to remember your actions and preferences (such as language, font size and other display preferences) over a period of time, so you don't have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to the site or browse from one page to another.

3. What Do We Collect?

Cookies will not specifically identify the user, collecting information such as:

- Device type (e.g. mobile, computer, laptop, tablet)
- Operating system
- IP address
- Browser information (e.g., type, language, and history)
- Access times
- Settings
- Referring website addresses
- Other data about your device to provide the services as otherwise described in this policy

- Location information (we may receive your generic location, such as city or neighbourhood)

The information will be used internally for web site traffic analysis. However, we assume no responsibility for the security of this information.

This information helps us learn about the geographical distribution of our website visitors, and the technology they use to access our site. This information is never connected with the personal information you supply to us if you register with us as a customer.

4. **How are Cookies Used?**

We use Google Analytics to analyse the use of this website. Google Analytics generates statistical and other information about website use by means of cookies, which are stored on users' computers. The information generated relating to our website is used to create reports about the use of the website. Google will store this information.
